



Weekly or Bi-weekly

- **Lectio Divina:** (*Meets Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays ALL YEAR on Zoom.*)
Lectio Divina is a method of reading and listening, lingering with, and sharing personal responses to selected biblical texts. Diverse responses to the text provide new insights and help us grow in our spiritual lives and set intentions for our daily lives.
- **Meditation Groups:** *Meets Sunday, 9am (Zoom); and Monday, 6pm (in person)* Beginners and experienced meditators are welcome. Please feel free to drop in whenever you like.
